

Day 6: Different Kind of Graphs

Lesson Target: Student will construct Pictograph.

Process	Activities/Expected Students' responses	Teacher's Support
Understand the Goal (5 min.)	What do you learn from the bar graph?	
Explore/ Investigate/Solve (35 min.)	<p>Review: What did you do yesterday? S: We analyzed a graph</p> <p>Teach: T: There are a type of graph called, "pictograph". You can use a picture when you enter your data instead of bars.</p> <p>Introduce activity:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Draw horizontal and vertical lines just like bar graph 2. Outside of the graph, make "Key" box 3. Draw a picture that represent as one data in the key box 4. Enter a picture data in the graph. <p>Engage Student constructs their own pictograph.</p>	<p>Display four Data Chart</p> <p>Distribute rulers</p> <p>Support individually</p>
Conclude (5 min.)	<p>Evaluate each other Does my pictograph meet four criteria?</p>	Display student made pictographs

Assessment:

- **Include** all 4 criteria, shown above, in their pictograph
